"	Men," he (Paul) said, "I believe there is trouble ahead if we go on—shipwreck, loss of cargo, and danger to our lives as well." But the officer in charge of the prisoners listened more to the ship's captain and the owner than to Paul. <u>Acts 27:10-11</u> NLT
2.	THE .
ti	And since Fair Havens was an exposed harbor—a poor place to spend the winter—most of the crew wanted to go on to Phoenix, farther up the coast of Crete, and spend the winter there. Phoenix was a good harbor with only a southwest and northwest exposure. Acts 27:12 NLT
3.	DEPEND ON
	When a light wind began blowing from the south, the sailors thought they could make it. So they pulled up anchor and sailed close to the shore of Crete.But the weather changed abruptly, and a wind of typhoon strength (called a "northeaster") burst across the island and blew us out to sea. Acts 27:13-14 NLT
4.	TO
	The sailors couldn't turn the ship into the wind, so they gave up and let it run before the gale. <u>Acts 27:15</u> NLT
5.	PUTIN THE
Th	en the sailors bound ropes around the hull of the ship to strengthen it. They were afraid of being driven across to the sandbars of Syrtis off the African coast, so they lowered the sea anchor to slow the ship and were driven before the wind. <u>Acts 27:17</u> NLT
6.	THINGS THAT ARE
Th	ne next day, as gale-force winds continued to batter the ship, the crew began throwing the cargo overboard. The following day they even took some of the ship's gear and threw it overboard. Acts 27:18-19 NLT
7.	OF WHAT .
	The terrible storm raged for many days, blotting out the sun and the stars, until at last all hope was gone. Acts 27:20 NLT
